

**AGREEMENT RENEWING THE ALLIANCE
BETWEEN

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and the Environmental Contractors Association (ECA), the Masons Tenders District Council (MTDC) and the International Association of Heat & Frost Insulators Local 12A (IAHFI 12A) hereby renew the Alliance agreement signed on January 23, 2007. OSHA, ECA, MTDC and IAHFI 12A continue to recognize the value of collaborative efforts to achieve workplace safety. OSHA, ECA, MTDC and IAHFI 12A remain committed to cooperative and proactive efforts to advance workplace safety and health. In renewing this Alliance, OSHA, ECA, MTDC and IAHFI 12A recognize that OSHA's State Plan and Consultation Project partners are an integral part of the OSHA national effort

OSHA's Alliances provide parties an opportunity to participate in a voluntary cooperative relationship with OSHA for purposes such as training and education, outreach and communication and promoting a national dialogue on workplace safety and health. These Alliances have proved to be valuable tools for both OSHA and its Alliance participants. By entering into an Alliance with a party, OSHA is not endorsing any of that party's products or services; nor does the Agency enter into an Alliance with the purpose of promoting a particular party's products or services.



OSHA will afford the opportunity for representatives of the Occupational Safety and Health State Plan Association and the association of state Consultation Projects to participate as well.

This agreement will remain in effect for two years from the date of signing. This agreement may be modified at any time with the concurrence of both signatories and may be terminated for any reason with 30 days written notice from either signatory.




